CREMORNE resident Annie Crawford's can-do attitude has seen her win this year's Rotary Inspirational Women award.

Ms Crawford is the founder of Can Too, a foundation raising funds for cancer research through wellbeing and fitness programs. She believes she was nominated for the award as Can Too has the fundamentals that Rotary upholds: fundraising and community service.

"Reaching into the community is what Rotary is all about, and Can Too trains men and women across states, helping their fitness and also their mental health," she said.

Ms Crawford is also an ambassador for Opportunity International, which enables people in developing nations to start small businesses to help them escape the cycle of poverty.

"There are some amazing women out there who are all doing great things," she said.

"I don't know why I won the award, but it's a great opportunity to promote the cause."

Rotary spokesman Bob Aitken said this was the second year of the award which aimed to recognise women who make a significant difference in the community locally, regionally and internationally.

"Many of the nominated women have been quietly working away doing that for years, in different ways from literacy programs to providing funds for wells in developing countries," Mr Aitken said.
