The project aims to exhibit works by emerging, mid career and established photographers. You may portray any aspect of Sydney – an every day occurrence, an unusual or particular moment or place, the diversity of cultures, etc. Avoid work that feeds into clichés (eg. sunsets over the Sydney Harbour Bridge or sunset beach scenes).

The Sydney Life Photography Prize is valued at \$10,000 (comprised of \$5,000 cash, plus a \$5,000 investment in the AMP Capital Sustainable Share Fund). Submissions close at 5pm, Tuesday 7 July 2009.

Transformers - Bigger & Better at Imax



Decepticon forces return to Earth on a mission to take Sam Witwicky prisoner, after the young hero learns the truth about the ancient origins of the Transformers. Joining the mission to protect humankind is Optimus Prime, who forms an alliance with international armies for a second epic battle. Starring Megan Fox and Shia LaBeouf.

Experience the full scale size of Optimus Prime, captured in a few scenes of the IMAX version of the film. The film has been shot in part with IMAX cameras, and expands vertically to fill the entire IMAX Darling Harbour screen, about 30 metres high.

The only way to see this movie is on IMAX. Never before has there been 4k rendered character animation shot on full IMAX 70 mm film. This is a first and the results are stunning. Starts 25 June 2009.
