

CAN'T RUN? Can now. Join the Can Too run program for the September Sydney running festival. The idea is to raise money for Cure Cancer, while reaching a personal goal. Sign up

on your own or with friends, at www.cantoo.org.au. You get a daily training schedule from start until race day, and the opportunity to join group training sessions. Founder Annie Crawford says last year's program turned novice runners into marathoners, and raised \$100,000. Training starts June 7 for the half-marathon; July 5 for the 9km run.
